• Status: Full Time, \$48,000 Salaried - Exempt

General Responsibilities: As a member of the CalWORKs contract and under the supervision of the Senior Case Manager, the position will provide direct services, education, information, and referrals to survivors of Domestic Violence/Intimate Partner Violence (DV/IPV).

Specific Responsibilities:

- Conduct initial client assessment and intake.
- Monitor and provide support services, information and referrals through appointments or walk-ins.
- Recommend interventions and/ or referrals as appropriate, based on client needs.
- Provide service assessments: prioritizing client needs. Service Plan: develop goals and timeline to
 achieve goals with client (including employment/vocational assistance and referrals). Client
 Advocacy: phone calls, coordination of services on behalf of the clients. Reassess and revise
 service plan as needed; and follow-up with clients to assess and referrals for additional services
 (i.e. legal assistance, housing, clothing, substance abuse, mental health, education, etc).
 Thorough documentation on each client.
- Co-facilitate and/ or conduct open groups, structured closed groups and individual counseling to residents (Anger Management group, DV/IPV group, Parenting Skills, Life Skills, Resume-writing, job search, etc., therapeutic groups, etc.)
- Provide direct services and transportation based on client needs, including childcare while adult clients access services at the site.
- Assist the program in developing and documenting culturally sensitive understanding of the target population.
- Assist in training community network staff representatives.
- Complete and e-file Temporary Restraining Orders.
- Assist and attend all outreach events, including assigned Job Club outreach.
- Attend designated training seminars in-person or by webinar.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Qualifications: Must be fully vaccinated. Must have an Associate of Arts Degree with two (2) years' experience in human or social services or a High School Diploma/GED equivalent with at least four (4) years' experience in human or social services. Must have familiarity with the needs of the underrepresentative population. Must have intermediate skills of word, excel, pdf and web/conference technology. Preferably experience in working with domestic violence and crisis intervention services. 40-Hour Domestic Violence Victims Advocacy Certificate.
