

## Ms. Curtis's Supply List

- 2 boxes of 24 crayons (prefer Crayola brand)
- 8 glue sticks
- 4 Ticonderoga fat pencils
- 2 three pronged plastic two pocket folder
- 1 yellow, orange, green, or pink highlighter
- 4 pack of black Expo (dry erase) markers
- Package of 100 3x5 white index cards
- 1 composition notebook wide ruled (ABC/math journal)
- 1 spiral notebook (wide ruled) 70 pages (science journal)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 3 containers of baby wipes
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 package of napkins (500 or more)
- 1 back pack (write child's name on outside of it). Make sure it can fit the three pronged two pocket folder, and child's lunch box.
- 1 lunch box (write child's name on outside of it)
- 1 bag of extra clothes to be kept at school. These clothes are used in case of spills, accidents etc. Please include a pair of pants, pair of shorts, one long sleeve and one short sleeve shirt, pair of socks, and 2 pair of underwear. Put these in a Ziploc bag with your child's name written on it.
- Nap time supplies-a small blanket that will cover your child (no bedspreads or sleeping bags), and a small sized pillow. You child may bring one small stuffed soft friend to nap with. No hard plastic items. They will keep their stuffed friend here at school. It can be exchanged when they bring home their nap time supplies home to be washed (monthly).
- One tote bag- no suitcases to transport nap time supplies home to be washed monthly. Please make sure your child's name is written on the front of it. The tote bags will stay at school as well.

Optional: These are other items we use during the school year for cooking projects, art projects, and center activities. You are welcome to donate any item from this list, but it is not required.

- Assorted pom poms
- Sandwich Ziploc baggies
- glue bottle
- brown lunch bags
- paper plates
- dried beans, peas, rice, or any kind of pasta.
