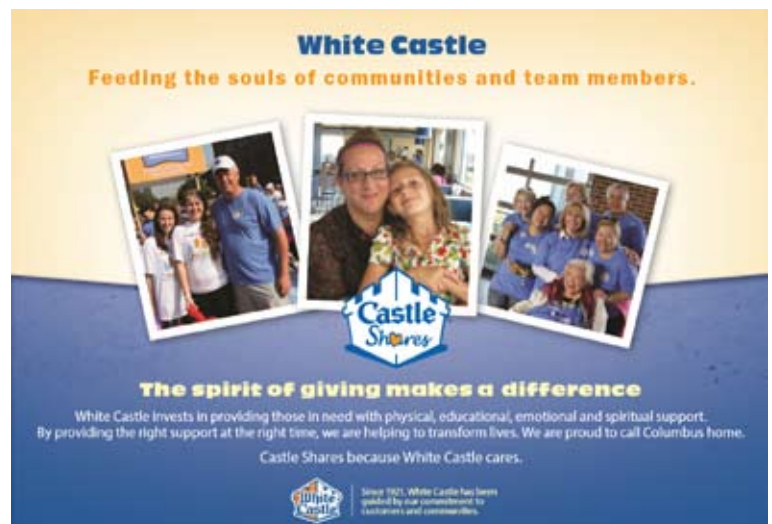

SPEECH SERVICES

Speech-language delays in children may impact future success in school. Our experienced team of speech therapists provides evaluations and treatment for a variety of areas including stuttering, apraxia and voice. Our services include individual & group therapy, evaluations, school contract services, and more.

SUPPORT SERVICE PROVIDER PROGRAM

Our SSPs are trained sighted guides and providers of visual information. They enable people with combined vision and hearing loss to do everyday tasks and activities independently. SSPs provide the following services: community outings, leisure reading, grocery shopping, errands, banking, doctor visits

DUBLIN AUDIOLOGY OFFICE

The new office, located at 5155 Bradenton Ave., Suite 150 in Dublin, specializes in audiology services, hearing evaluations, hearing aid consultations and fittings, custom hearing protection, special program and follow up care. Dr. Natalie Rosselli and Dr. Jennifer Thomson serve as the onsite audiologists.

AUDIOLOGY & HEARING AID SERVICES

Hearing loss impacts every aspect of a person's life. That's why we make it our goal to provide highly personalized care and hearing aids for all lifestyles and budgets.
