WAFER eases the burden of the increasing number of La Crosse County residents who either skip meals or eat less just to make ends meet. WAFER helps anyone in need of food, with no exception. Some examples of those we help include:

- The working poor
- Single parents
- Young families who are on the lower end of the pay scale
- Elderly and/or disabled who are on fixed incomes
- People who are unable to work due to injury or illness
- People who are victims of domestic violence
- People with unexpected events such as car repairs, accidents, theft, fire, or calamity

St. Clare's Health Mission was founded in 1992 by representatives of health and social service organizations throughout our community in a collaborative effort to address health care access for the poor and uninsured.

The Mission has cared for over 12,000 patients in over 50,000 visits since it's inception in 1993. St. Clare Health Mission is open for walk in care on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.

Funding for the Mission, including medical supplies such as pharmaceuticals, is paid for through community donations. Pharmaceuticals alone cost roughly \$250,000.00 per year.
