FIRST READING

Deuteronomy 6:4-15

"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God
with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I
command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your
children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the
way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. You shall bind them as a sign on your

hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

“And when the Lord your God brings you into the land that he swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give you—with great and good cities that you did not build, and houses full of all good things that you did not fill, and cisterns that you did not dig, and vineyards and olive trees that you did not plant—and when you eat and are full, then take care lest you forget the Lord, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. It is the Lord your God you shall fear. Him you shall serve and by his name you shall swear. You shall not go after other gods, the gods of the peoples who are around you, for the Lord your God in your midst is a jealous God, lest the anger of the Lord your God be kindled against you, and he destroy you from off the face of the earth.”

Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Brothers, what shall we do?” And Peter said to them, “Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. CONFSSION AND FORGIVENESS

Pastor: We are all sinners. We have all fallen short of God's expectations of us. Many times we do not ask our Lord, by faith, to bless us with wise decisions but choose to make them on our own. However, our great God gives us the opportunity to confess our sins to him and receive his forgiveness.

People: **Our lack of faith often moves us to trust in ourselves rather than in you, Lord.**

We say that we want to lead lives that demonstrate our faith in you.

Yet all too often we trust only in ourselves.

We say that we are Spirit-led people,

Making Spirit-led decisions.

In reality we often choose not to call on you.

Forgive us, Lord, for our lack of faith.

Help us to be renewed by the pure faith which you can and do provide for us.

Pastor: *God assures us that he hears our sincere and humble confession. He has promised that he will listen. Now hear these words which God speaks to you through me. Your sins are forgiven because of what Christ has done for you. Go now and live your lives, relying on faith in our great God.*

People: **On the night he was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took bread and blessed it.**

He broke the bread, gave it to his disciples, and said,

Pastor: "Take this and eat it. This is my body, which is given for you. Do this to remember me."

People: **Then he took a cup and spoke a prayer of thanksgiving. He gave it to them and said,**

"Drink from it, all of you. This is my blood, the blood of the covenant. It is poured out for many people so that sins are forgiven."

Gathered in the name and the remembrance of Jesus, we beg you, O Lord, to forgive, renew, and strengthen us with your Word and Spirit. Grant us faithfully to eat his body and drink his blood as he bids us do in his own testament. Hear us as we pray in his name and as he taught us:
