



Position: Van Driver

Duties: Transport our participants between the Wise Adult Day Health program in Taunton and their residences in the greater Taunton area. We have openings for regular shifts, and we also have per diem van driver openings to cover routes for our regular drivers when they are off.

Hours: Generally between 6 and 10:00 a.m. and between 1:30 and 6 p.m. Mon-Fri; No nights, weekends or holidays.

Qualifications:

- Valid driver's license with clean driving record; must be comfortable driving or learning to drive a 14-passenger mini-bus. A CDL is NOT required, just a regular driver's license.
- Ability to pass a drug and alcohol test and a criminal background check.
- Proof of a physical exam and a TB test within the last year.
- CPR and First Aid Certification; we can provide training for this certification after hire, but you'll need it before you can drive on your own.
- Physical ability to bend, kneel, squat, and fit into small spaces between wheelchairs on a van.
- Desire and physical ability to assist our elderly clients, many of whom face a variety of mental and physical challenges.
- Driving experience and/or experience caring for similar clientele are preferred but not necessary, as we will train the right person.
