- Analyze system practices and recommend changes in techniques, security, programs, equipment, and procedures to improve efficiency while maintaining and improving security.
- Install, maintain, repair, and troubleshoot virtual infrastructure, servers (physical and virtual), firewalls, workstations, routers/switches, software/applications, and other computer systems and related equipment.
- Develop and maintain detailed records on operating, repairing, and maintaining computers, networks, and software applications.
