Duties include but not limited to: Responsible for developing, organizing, implementing and coordinating the daily operation of COA programs and the non-medical day care services program in accordance with participants' needs and all mandatory requirements. Maintains and updates the government tracking program; submits annual reports to the Massachusetts Office of Elderly Affairs. Oversees all aspects of grant and programming budgets.
