Supports may include life skills, social skills, community integration, and employment services and supports.

We welcome staff with previous experience and provide training to those new to the field of direct care. Medical Administration Policy (MAP) training is required and provided free of charge to all CO-OP direct care staff.

Requirements:

- Valid Driver's license & good driving record required
- Acceptable Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) & Fingerprinting required
- MAP certification is required within three months of hire date - Higher pay rate is based on being MAP certified
