Downtown Taunton Pumpkin Extravaganza

Downtown Taunton Foundation (DTF) invites the public to join us for the 2nd Annual Pumpkin Extravaganza in beautiful and historic downtown Taunton. Pumpkins will be displayed at Liberty & Union Park as well as on Main Street in Downtown Taunton from Friday October 22nd thru Sunday October 31st. Pumpkins will be lit on October 22, 23, 29, 30 & 31, weather & pumpkin health permitting, from 5:30 pm thru 8 pm. For safety, pumpkins will be lit with battery powered lights.

The public is invited to join in the fun by entering a carved pumpkin into the contest. Individuals, organizations, businesses, and groups are welcome to enter pumpkins that are in good taste and suitable for all ages. To register and receive contest guidelines, email ekelleher@downtowntaunton.org with your name and/or group name and the name of your pumpkin by Monday October 18th. Pumpkins must be dropped off at Trescott Street Gallery on Thursday October 21st between 1:00-6:00 pm OR at Liberty & Union Park on Friday October 22nd between 3 -5 pm.

Judging will take place from 6:30-7:00 pm on Friday 10/22. Winners will be marked with place ribbons by 7 PM and announced on Facebook where photos of the entries will also be posted. Ribbons will be awarded for most CREATIVE, SCARIEST & FUNNIEST carvings.

Many businesses and individuals have already signed-up including students in the Design & Visual Communications program at Bristol-Plymouth Regional Technical High School who will be entering 20 pumpkins, Taunton Antiques, Taunton Thrift, Tex Barry's, and Ferreira Co, and several local families. All are welcome to visit the downtown to stroll through and view the Pumpkin Extravaganza AND the Downtown Scarecrows.
