

Important Advanced Placement Exam Registration Information 2018-2019

Student Registration:

- All students pay a \$10.00 non-refundable registration fee

GCPS students enrolled in AP Courses:

- Gwinnett County Public Schools will pay for 1 exam for each student.
- Each additional exam is \$94.00, with the exception of AP Seminar which is \$142.
 - GCPS will only pay for AP Seminar if it is the only exam that a student is taking.

GCPS students who are Free/Reduced Lunch students and enrolled in AP Courses:

- Gwinnett County Public Schools will pay for all exams.

Students NOT enrolled in Gwinnett County Public Schools AP Courses:

- Cost is \$94.00 per exam, with the exception of AP Seminar which is \$142.

Note: There is a **\$15.00** return fee per exam for any registered exam student does not take.

Use of your student's Social Security Number (SSN) on AP Exams

The College Board asks for the student's Social Security Number (SSN), which is optional, on each exam the student takes during his/her high school career. The use of the student's SSN as the unique identifier on each exam allows for the most effective transfer of all the student's AP scores to a college or university. The school district does not require students to use their SSN and recommends that parents and students discuss the use of the SSN before exam administration.
