
GRADUATE EXIT SURVEY AND DASHBOARD - JOB AID

This job aid provides an overview of the Graduate Exit Survey using the Qualtrics online survey platform. A GCPS high school graduating senior can complete the survey from their student portal. The high school counselor can complete (or update) the survey on the student's behalf through the Graduate Survey Completion dashboard.

The survey is accessible using a desktop, laptop, or mobile device (phone, or tablet), and through Google Chrome, or Microsoft Edge browsers.

Accessing the Graduate Exit Survey (as a student):

1. A high school graduating senior must be logged into their student portal to access the Graduate Exit Survey:



2. Once the link is clicked, the student will be routed to the welcome page to the Graduate Exit Survey:






- 3. The survey includes a series of questions:

Please note:


All follow-up questions are dependent on the post-graduation choice selected. For example – "Enlisting in the Military" is the post-graduation selected.

The next question will display the military branch for the student (or counselor) to select (i.e. –Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marines, National Guard, Navy, Other):




College Application Information:

The survey includes questions regarding the college application process:



Changes to entries submitted previously can be made at this screen only and cannot be changed afterwards.



Scholarship Information:

The survey includes questions regarding scholarships:

- Name of the scholarship
- Select the purpose/intent of the survey (i.e., Academic, Athletics, Arts)
- Select the source the scholarship is offered (i.e., College, Parent Association, etc.)
- Select the number of years the scholarship will be awarded to the student (1-5 years)
- The scholarship dollar amount (Note: \$125,000.00 as the maximum amount permitted)
- Click the "Back" button to make edits to the scholarship information entered.
- Enter additional scholarships awarded. After entering the final scholarship, the survey ends:
