#GOCOWLS is the weekly newsletter sent out each Thursday to parents, students, and staff. It is important to read this communication each week to stay informed throughout the school year. The first edition of the 2021-2022 #GOCOWLS will come to your email during the first week of August.

New Student Orientation is **mandatory for all new students** and optional for returning students. New parents are strongly encouraged to join their students during orientation. New Student Orientation for grades 4 – 6 will be in person on campus Wednesday, August 11 from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM.

First Day of Class is Monday, August 16, 2021. Students will have access to their courses beginning Wednesday, August 11. While all students can review the orientation lesson in the courses, the official first day of classes is not until Monday, August 16. **All Students in grades 4 & 5 should plan on coming on campus for the first day of class on August 16 from 9:00 – 12:15.** This will provide the elementary students with a strong start to the school year with teachers supporting the first day of classes.

Learning Labs are in-person learning opportunities each week. Students in grades 4 & 5 come on campus Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9:00 – 12:15. Grade 6 students have Learning Labs on Tuesday mornings from 9:00 – 12:15. Back to School Welcome and Photo ID's - Tuesday, August 17 beginning at 8:00 AM. Students will receive personal lab schedules on lanyards.
