

## Who we are:

In 1962, a group of parents and providers envisioned a shared space where rehabilitation agencies could collaborate while maintaining their unique missions. They dreamed of a fully accessible building with classrooms, therapy suites, work areas, a therapeutic pool, and a gym—designed to serve people with special needs. With strong community support, that vision became a reality when the AI Sigl Center opened in 1968 at the original Elmwood Campus in Rochester.

Today, AI Sigl Community of Agencies has grown from serving 3,000 individuals to more than 55,000 people of all ages and abilities each year. For over 60 years, our inclusive model—now spanning six campuses—has stood as a national example of collaboration and coordinated care.

## What we provide:

AI Sigl provides affordable, high-quality real estate and business services, allowing our Member Agencies to focus on delivering life-changing programs. We offer rent that is nearly 30% below the Rochester market average. Reducing overhead while providing reliable operations support helps provide more direct care.

As a collaborative hub, AI Sigl brings people and ideas together to strengthen services, amplify impact, and demonstrate that we can *Achieve More Together*. By sharing space and offering complementary—not competing—services, our Member Agencies are able to reach more individuals and families across our community.
