DO (repeated actions)		
	everyday activities	I do exercises everyday. She does the laundry on Monday.
	homework	Did you do your homework?
	dishes laundry inventory chores cleaning	Every day I do the dishes, laundry, and chores.

MAKE (creative)		
	food	I make my children's lunches everyday
	jewelry	She makes earrings and necklaces for her friends.
	clothing furniture	My friend makes her clothes. Her husband makes furniture.

MAKE (not regular)		
	appointments	We need to make an appointment at the dentist.
	beds	Please make your bed before you go to school.
	someone angry, sad happy, crazy, mad, upset.	It makes me happy when my family is together.
