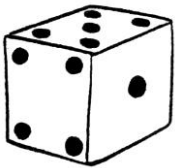


Let's Talk

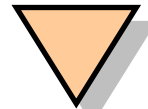
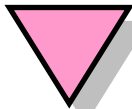

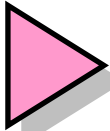

Talk about the oldest person in your family.

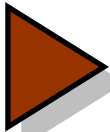
How many children do you want to have? Why?

Being married or single: which is better?

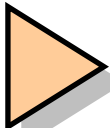
Talk about what your family does on the weekend.
