1. **Get** (buy/install) a smoke alarm.
2. **Test** (check) the smoke alarm every week.



3. **Change** the smoke alarm batteries every year.



4. **Keep** children out of the kitchen when you are cooking.
5. **Watch** the pan when you are cooking with fat or oil.



6. **Make** sure cigarettes are out.



7. Don't **put** (place) too many plugs in extension leads.
