Great Britain

13 Colonies

Colonists

High Taxes

Revolutionary War

- The colonists formed an army and went to war with Great Britain.
- This war is called the American Revolutionary War.
- It lasted from 1775-1783.



Peace Treaty

- France, Spain, Canada and the Netherlands helped the American colonists fight the war.
- The war ended in 1778 when the *Treaty of Paris* was signed.



United States

- The *Treaty of Paris* recognized the new nation--*The United States of America.*
