

The Statue of Liberty

The Statue of Liberty is located in New York Harbor. It is one hundred and fifty-one feet tall. The statue on a base which is ninety-three meters tall. If you walk up the statue you will walk one hundred and sixty-two steps. The Crown on the top of the statue has seven points representing the seven continents. The statue sits on Liberty Island which is fourteen square acres and located one and a half miles from Manhattan. You can take a boat to the island that takes about fifteen minutes. It's very popular with tourists; about ten thousand people visit it every day. The price of admission is about fourteen dollars and the trip takes about three hours. Plan your visit today!
