


September 11th Timeline

The hijackers on board American Airlines Flight 11 crash the plane into floors 93-99 of the North Tower of the World Trade Center Towers, killing everyone on board and hundreds inside the building.	8:14 a.m.
Passengers and crew members aboard Flight 93 attempt to retake control of the plane after hearing about the attacks. As a result, the hijackers crash the plane into a field in Somerset County, Pennsylvania. This kills all 40 passengers and crew on board.	9:59 a.m.

The two planes that destroyed the North and South Towers took off from Boston Logan International Airport.

2. Where did each of the flights take off from?

3. What did President Bush have to say at his address to the nation that evening?

The attacks were “evil, despicable acts of terror.” He declared that America, its friends and allies would “stand together to win the war against terrorism.”

4. Who addressed the nation at 8:30 p.m. to declare that America would “stand together to win the war against terrorism?”

President George Bush

5. What happened to the 7 World Trade Center? What time did this occur?

It collapsed after burning for hours. The building had been evacuated in the morning, and there were no casualties. The collapse occurred at 5:20 p.m.
