Lutheran World Relief values the health and safety of our community members, donors and volunteers. Until we know more about the Coronavirus or COVID-19, we have made the decision to postpone the collection of Quilts & Kits of Care for April 2020 & May 2020.

These are unprecedented times. We made the decision to postpone collections for the following reasons:

- 1. We care about the health & safety of our community members
- 2. We want to abide by the guidelines of the CDC (Centers for Disease Control) and elected officials to limit gatherings to no more than (10) people.
- 3. Churches are closed, so many quilters & kit makers can't meet to facilitate an Ingathering.
- 4. Colleges are closed, so some of the labor for Ingatherings is not available. Again...We care about the health & safety of our community members!!

I have been working with Janel at LWR to try to figure all this out, and she has been wonderful. We will postpone our April 15th gathering till the fall. I will need to work out all the details with TLU and then will get back to folks with a final date.

I know it will be hard to store things, but it is important that we all stay well. Thank you all for understanding the hard decisions that needed to be made.
