This summer Guadalupe Valley Habitat for Humanity will be traveling to Nayarit, Mexico to build a home in partnership with Habitat for Humanity Mexico! The trip cost is \$1900 (not including airfare.) Your trip cost includes accommodations, meals, transportation in country, cultural activities and a donation to Habitat for Humanity Mexico. Our team will fly into the Puerto Vallarta Licenciado Gustavo Diaz Ordaz International Airport (PVR).

Why we build: In Mexico, nearly 16 million people live in homes with dirt floors, roofs made of tin, cardboard or debris and walls made of mud, reeds, palm or sheet. Almost 25 million have no access to basic services of potable water, septic, electricity and fuel for cooking or eating food and more than 500,000 families live in overcrowded conditions.

Project Description: Volunteers will assist families in building new homes of concrete block. Typical volunteer tasks could include: digging foundations or septic pits, moving and compacting dirt, mixing mortar and concrete, laying bricks, tying rebar or painting.

What to expect: Volunteers arrive in Puerto Vallarta Airport and are driven 2 hours to the team hotel in Chacala. Each weekday teams will travel 30 minutes to the project site. Cultural opportunities during the week may include visiting Chacalilla Beach, a boat tour, visiting a local petroglyph site, market or school, or a hands on tortilla making workshop.

Highlights: Building in Nayarit gives volunteers the opportunity to experience an international location with a familiar feel and minimal time zone change from other parts of North America!
