Cabbage 2027 Crop

July 1 deadline to enroll/renew

Coverage is available in Brooks, Colquitt, Cook, Mitchell, Tift and Toombs counties

Fresh Market Sweet Corn 2027 Crop

July 31 deadline to enroll/renew

Coverage is available in Colquitt, Decatur, Grady, Miller, Mitchell, Seminole, Tift and Worth counties.

Peppers 2027 crop

July 31 deadline to enroll/renew

Coverage is available in Brooks, Colquitt, Cook, Echols, Grady, Lowndes, Thomas, Tift, Ware and Worth counties.

The USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA) reminds Georgia producers of these sale closing dates for the 2027 crop year. Current policyholders who wish to make changes to their existing coverage also have until the sales closing date to do so. Federal crop insurance is critical to the farm safety net. It helps producers and owners manage revenue risks and strengthens the rural economy. Please contact your insurance agent to see if your county is covered. Growers are encouraged to visit their crop insurance agent soon to learn specific details for the 2027 crop year. Crop insurance is sold and delivered solely through private crop insurance agents.
