

2025 PESTICIDE CLEAN DAY

May 13 St. Ives Country Club 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. Johns Creek

This program, administered by the Georgia Department of Agriculture through funding from the EPA, gives everyone an opportunity to discard old, unusable, or canceled pesticides. No fees are charged for participation in this program, and all accepted materials will be turned over to a hazardous waste contractor for disposal. The event is open to all private and commercial applicators with the understanding that the event is designed / intended for farmers, lawn care, golf courses, and pest control companies, statewide. **Individuals wishing to participate in the program must fill out the pre-registration form and return it to Brad Baker, Clean Day Waste Disposal Coordinator by May 8.** This information is necessary to plan for the collection, transportation, and disposal of the waste pesticides collected.
