It's important for farmers to make their voice heard on this pivotal issue. This committee, chaired by Rep. Lynn Smith (R-Newnan) will examine aspects of navigable streams in Georgia & issues surrounding their ownership, private & public rights of use & related matters. This committee was formed to hold further discussion regarding issues that arose from [HB 1172](#), which was passed this year and [SB 115](#) last year.
