



CITY COUNCIL'S MESSAGE

March 5, 2026

Due to the blizzard our region experienced last week, the February 24 City Council meeting was canceled – therefore, there is no new business to report at this time. Because of that cancellation, each of the items listed on the February 24 meeting agenda will be added to the agenda for our next City Council meeting, which will take place at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, March 10, on the third floor of City Hall.

As we mentioned earlier, City Council hosted a Budget Workshop on February 12 to review Sea Isle City's proposed 2026 Municipal Budget. Following additional consideration, the proposed 2026 Municipal Budget will be Introduced during Council's March 10 meeting, with a Public Hearing (and possible Adoption) planned during our April 14 meeting.

Also during the March 10 City Council meeting, our Municipal Engineer, Andrew Previti, will give a presentation regarding shade structures being added to Sea Isle City's playground on JFK Boulevard, which has been an ongoing topic of discussion in recent years. Council looks forward to learning more about the options Mr. Previti will share with us on March 10 (and discussing the costs for each).

In addition to discussions about the budget, City Council and the city's Administration continue to work together and discuss a variety of topics that affect our community.

Like many of you, we are very happy to see the snow from the recent storm continue to melt away, and we look forward to seeing everyone at upcoming events, including Sea Isle City's 2026 Saint Patrick's Day Parade at 3:30 PM on Saturday, March 14. We are also eager to see warmer weather arrive – and to welcome back our neighbors and friends as they return to town for the approaching summer season, which we are confident will be very successful!
