



CITY COUNCIL'S MESSAGE

June 16, 2022

At the start of the June 14 City Council meeting, Mayor Desiderio stated that he will continue to work to bring about change to the current State laws that weaken local law enforcement's ability to maintain public safety – in particular as they relate to issues involving juveniles. The Mayor also reminded everyone that Sea Isle City is still “as safe as ever,” and that anyone who sees or hears anything that they feel is a problem should call the police right away – because that's why our police officers are there.

Also on June 14, City Council approved numerous resolutions that authorized the annual issuance of ABC licenses to all of the businesses in Sea Isle City that sell liquor.

City Council also approved each of the Resolutions on their June 14 Consent Agenda, including...

- Resolution 095, which authorized the submittal of a Grant Application to the New Jersey Department of Transportation's Municipal Aid Road Agreement program for the reconstruction of Cini Avenue from JFK Boulevard to 36th Street.
- Resolution 096, which authorized the cancellation of Developer's Escrow Accounts.
- Resolution 097, which ratified a Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Sea Isle City and the Fraternal Order of Police's Lodge 7 Rank-and-File through December 31, 2023, which is subject to Presentation and Adoption of a Contract in conformance of same.
- Resolution 099, which accepted a Technology Management Proposal for I.T. Upgrades and Consulting from Contemporary Technologies, not to exceed \$40,000.
- Resolution 101, which awarded approval of the lowest quote submitted for the purchase of trash bags from Pabco Industries, in the amount of \$20,536.
- Resolution 102, which authorized a Professional Services Contract for Newspaper and Media Advertisements with Seven Mile Publishing, not to exceed \$45,100.

The next City Council meeting takes place on Tuesday, June 28, at 10:00 AM on the third floor of City Hall – and we hope to see you there!
