



CITY COUNCIL'S MESSAGE

November 2, 2023

During the October 24 City Council meeting, two ordinances were Introduced with First Reading: Ordinance 1706, which was written to appropriate \$3,200,000 for Sea Isle City's upcoming Beach Replenishment Project; and Ordinance 1707, which was written to amend the existing construction ordinance and establish the lowest floor elevation of unfinished spaces (such as garage slabs) at 2-feet above the top of the curb.

Ordinances 1706 and 1707 will each have Second Reading and Public Hearing (and possible adoption) during the November 14 City Council meeting.

Also on October 24, City Council adopted Ordinances 1702 and 1705. Ordinance 1702 amended the existing ordinance related to the construction of new homes, so to meet FEMA flood requirements; and Ordinance 1705 increased the cost of Sea Isle City's beach tags by \$5 (for daily, weekly, and seasonal tags).

Each of the resolutions on the October 24 Consent Agenda was approved, including...

- Resolution 179, which recognized Sea Isle City's Personnel Manual, which must be updated every two years.
- Resolution 180, which authorized a contract in the amount of \$5,935 with Rileigh's Outdoor Décor, of Bethlehem, PA, for the purchase of new holiday decorations and the refurbishment of older decorations.

Our next regular City Council meeting will take place at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, November 14, on the third floor of City Hall – and we hope to see you there!
