



CITY COUNCIL'S MESSAGE

January 8, 2026

City Council's most recent meeting took place on Friday, January 2; and the main purpose of that meeting was to adopt Sea Isle City's 2026 Temporary Budget, which was adopted via Resolution 001, allowing the city to operate normally until the 2026 Municipal Budget is officially adopted later this year.

During the "Citizen Comment" portion of the January 2 meeting, several property owners stepped to the microphone to comment on various topics, including...

- Questions about the Community Center's membership fees, which City Council clarified.
- Concerns regarding setback regulations for inground swimming pools.
- Gratitude because the city will be charging pickleball fees.
- Concerns regarding the number of parked vehicles on private properties during the summer.
- Concerns regarding the use of online rental websites – and if the owners of local properties are obtaining rental permits from the city.
