

## **IMPORTANT SEASONAL REMINDERS:**

**Summer Trash & Recycling Collections:** As of Memorial Day, the Summer Trash & Recycling Collection schedule is in effect, with two (2) curbside collections per week per street: 1st to 44th Street on Wednesdays & Saturdays, 45th to 70th Street on Mondays & Thursdays, and 71st to 94th Street on Tuesdays & Fridays.

**Parking Meters:** Parking fees are in effect from May 15 to Labor Day. The parking rate is 25-cents for 15-minutes (up to the maximum time allowed for each specific parking space). Meters are in effect from Monday to Saturday, 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. (except at the Marina Parking Lot along 42<sup>nd</sup> Place, which is 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.). Meters are also operational on Sundays from 12 noon to 11:00 p.m.

**Park Smart:** Please be sure to park your vehicle in legal spots only. Don't park in yellow areas and don't block people's driveways. Also, do not park in a manner that will block sidewalks, because this forces people in wheelchairs and families with small children to walk out into the street to get around your vehicle – and thus puts them in harm's way. And, please check for signs that specify parking restrictions in the area where you park.

**Beach Tags:** Beach Tags are required for all beaches from Memorial Day Weekend to Labor Day, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Beach Tags are required for everyone 12 years and older and can be purchased on the beach. You can also purchase beach tags at the Welcome Center Beach Tag Office, 300 JFK Boulevard, which is open 7-days a week, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. during the summer season. Beach Tags fees: Daily = \$5, Weekly (Sat.-Sat.) = \$10, and Seasonal = \$25. Wednesdays are free beach days, when no beach tags are required (except on July 4<sup>th</sup>).

**Bicycles:** Bicycles must follow the same rules of the road as vehicles (drive single-file on the right side of the road, stop at stop signs, yield to pedestrians, etc., etc.). Also, bike riders under the age of 17 must wear a bike helmet (by law). Always remember "safety first" when riding your bike!

**Beach Safety and Beach Etiquette:** Always swim near a lifeguard – and always be courteous of beachgoers around you.

**No Alcohol on Public Property:** Alcohol is not permitted on any public property, including Sea Isle's beaches and parks – or while walking along the sidewalk. Plain-clothed police officers will be on the beach and elsewhere around town this summer, so leave your adult beverages at home or at the bar!

**Stop for Pedestrians:** Motorists are reminded to stop for pedestrians at all intersection and crosswalks – even if there are no white "cross walk" lines painted in the street. HOWEVER, no pedestrian shall suddenly leave the curb or other safe place and walk or run into the path of a vehicle that is so close that it is impossible for the driver to yield. So, drivers please be courteous, and pedestrians please make sure it is safe to cross before walking into the street.

**Info Kiosk at Excursion Park:** New information boards are now in place at the Information Kiosk located on the sidewalk where JFK meets the promenade at Excursion Park. The info boards display a map of Sea Isle City, weekly summer event schedules and a monthly calendar of events. As always, for additional information about events happening in Sea Isle City, go to
