



CITY COUNCIL'S MESSAGE

November 19, 2020

Due to COVID-19, the November 10 City Council meeting was held remotely; however, members of the public were able to participate in the meeting telephonically.

At the start of the November 10 meeting, Mayor Desiderio reported that the Administration was creating a Veterans Tribute Video, which would be shared with the public on Veterans Day. The Mayor also reminded City Council that the City will be hosting a socially-distanced holiday parade with Santa Claus along Landis Avenue on Friday evening, November 27, and that the Chamber of Commerce's "Girls Weekend" event takes place November 20-23. Additionally, the Mayor announced that this year's New Year's Eve Celebration in the municipal gymnasium and Sea Isle's New Year's Eve fireworks show have both been cancelled.

Each of the resolutions on the November 10 Consent Agenda was approved, including...

Resolutions 184 and 185, which authorized contracts between the City and the Communications Workers of America union, which represents Sea Isle's Public Works employees.

Resolution 186, which authorized the purchase of traffic signs and related accessories in the amount of \$2,874 from Garden State Highway Products, which was based upon the solicitation of quotes.

Resolution 187, which authorized a contract in the amount of \$15,391 with Edmunds GovTech for hardware and software for the City's Financial Management System.

Resolution 188, which authorized a contract with Nehmad Perillo Davis & Goldstein in the amount of \$15,000 for a "Conflict Attorney" to represent the City in a lawsuit against the Zoning Board (due to an existing conflict with the board's solicitor).

Resolution 189, which clarified the award of contracts with various vendors for water and sewer pipes and fittings, to be ordered based on need and exact specifications.

Resolution 190, which appointed and re-appointed members of Sea Isle City's Zoning Board.

The next City Council meeting will take place on Tuesday, November 24, at 10:00 a.m. Due to the pandemic, the November 24 meeting will be held remotely; however members of the public will be able to participate in the meeting via telephone – and the public can also email questions and comments to the City Clerk's Office prior to the meeting (sromano@seaislecitynj.us). More information about the November 10 meeting will be forthcoming.
