The event began with a craft project for the kids, followed by a educational presentation by the Aherns. Then, everyone gathered in groups and watched closely as ten baby Diamondback Terrapin Turtles were released into the wetlands behind Dealy Field. The terrapins, which were rescued last summer as eggs taken from injured turtles on the roadways of Cape May County, were incubated at The Wetlands Institute for before being released into Sea Isle’s Marshes...
