



## **CITY COUNCIL'S MESSAGE**

*January 27, 2022*

During the “Mayor’s Report” portion of the January 25 City Council meeting, Mayor Desiderio noted that the Community Center project was moving forward and also that the Administration plans to perform minor renovations to the City’s Fire Department building, which will add sleeping quarters for the department’s overnight “Duty Crew.” Additionally, the Mayor publically thanked Sea Isle City’s CFO, Paula Doll, and wished her well in her approaching retirement.

Following the Mayor’s comments, City Council President Gibson similarly thanked Mrs. Doll for her efforts and gave her Council’s best wishes.

Also on January 25, Bond Ordinance 1676 was introduced with first reading. This Ordinance was written to appropriate \$20,000,000 for the construction of Sea Isle City’s future Community Center. Bond Ordinance 1676 will have second reading and possible adoption during the February 8 City Council meeting.

Each of the Resolutions on the January 25 Consent Agenda was approved, including...

- Resolution 009, which authorized professional services in the amount of \$21,700 with William McLees Architecture for renovations to the Fire Department building.
- Resolution 011, which authorized a Shared Services Agreement with Sea Isle City and the City of Ocean City for the services of Chief Financial Officer.
- Resolution 013, which authorized the procurement of water treatment tablets from Coyne Chemical in the amount of \$151.20 per pail, which is based on the lowest quote.
- Resolution 014, which authorized the procurement of a Proprietary Automatic License Plate Reader for the Sea Isle City Police Department in the amount of \$20,197.78 from General Sales Administration (T/A Major Police Supply).

The next City Council meeting will take place on Tuesday, February 8, at 10:00 AM inside Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall. City Council will also host a Budget Workshop inside Council Chambers at 9:00 AM on Thursday, February 10.
