



CITY COUNCIL'S MESSAGE

June 13, 2024

During the June 11 City Council meeting, three ordinances were adopted, following their Second Reading and Public Hearing...

- Ordinance 1716, which authorized Sea Isle City's membership in Cape May County's Mutual Aid and Assistance Agreement, which allows Sea Isle City to offer and receive Police, Fire, and EMS assistance to and from reciprocating communities in the case of an emergency.
- Ordinance 1717, which ensured Sea Isle City's compliance with the New Jersey Police Licensure Act, which states that all current and future law enforcement officers employed by the Sea Isle City Police Department must hold a valid, active license issued by the Police Training Commission.
- Ordinance 1718, which is a Bond Ordinance in the amount of \$2,915,000 that provides for various improvements to Sea Isle City's Water & Sewer Utility.

Each of the resolutions on the June 11 Consent Agenda was approved, including...

- Resolution 100, which authorized a Change Order for a Roadway Reconstruction Contract with Charles Marandino LLC, of Milford, NJ, decreasing the contract fee by \$55,166.
- Resolution 101, which authorized the award of a Construction Contract in the amount of \$281,050 to R. A. Walters & Sons for the Bulkhead Replace on 75th Street.
- Resolution 105, which authorized the issuance of a Raffle License to VFW Post 1963.
- Resolution 106, which authorized the issuance of a Raffle License to Saint Joseph Catholic Church.
- Resolution 108, which recognized the 140th Anniversary of Saint Joseph Catholic Church (founded in 1884).
- Resolution 110, which authorized the annual issuance of ABC Licenses to local establishments.
- Resolution 111, which authorized the Acceptance of Award and Execution of a Grant Agreement between the State of New Jersey's Office of Homeland Security & Preparedness and the City of Seaside City for Cybersecurity Services.
- Resolution 112, which authorized a State Contract in the amount of \$81,216 with Axon Enterprises Inc., of Scottsdale, AZ, for the purchase of Tasers for the Seaside City Police Department, which will replace older units with models that have updated technology.
- Resolution 113, which authorized Seaside City's 2024 Fireworks Displays (on July 4 and December 31).
- Resolution 114, which Ratified an Emergency Contract in the amount of \$140,800, with Walters Marine Construction for Beach Crossover Repairs at various locations.
- Resolution 115, which authorized the Advertisement for Bids for a Load & Pack Trash Truck for the Department of Public Works.

The next City Council meeting will take place on Tuesday, June 25, at 10:00 AM on the third floor of City Hall – and we hope to see you there!
