

UPDATE: GRANDVIEW POLICIES

In Connecticut we are fortunate to be able to enjoy camping while many others are sheltered in place. Still, while our state now has a decrease in Covid-19 cases, **it is imperative we do not take for granted the part we each play in the health and safety of our fellow campers.** With that in mind, we developed the following policies for the busy holiday at GrandView.

MASKS: are not required on your site, off-site must be with you and at-hand. MUST be worn when approaching other campers.

STORE: is open, limited to 3 campers at a time. Masks required, no children allowed at this time.

NO VISITORS Please advise your friends and family. **NO EXCEPTIONS**

POOL AND RESTROOMS: are open, subject to cleaning schedule.

CARS: Only **ONE** car per site, if RV plus tow vehicle. If you have more than one car, you must park in specified parking areas in campground.

SOCIAL DISTANCING AT POOL

1. No more than 20 people in pool/gated area at a time.
2. **PLEASE self-monitor** and share pool with others by not staying in pool for an extended period of time.
3. If other campers are waiting to enter gate and you have been there for a while, please exit so they can enter. You can return later.

STREAMLINE CHECK-IN! - NOT REQUIRED BUT VERY HELPFUL

1. Prepare your waiver and scan or take a picture of it and if needed pet vaccination and email to us. valarie@grandviewcampingresort.com
2. Pre-order and pre-pay for wood, to be delivered to your site on arrival.
3. Try to arrive by 6pm. Call 15 min before arrival. Notify us if you will be late.
