SETTING UP A SECURITY TEAM

DOES YOUR CHURCH HAVE A SECURITY TEAM? ARE YOU PREPARED FOR THE FULL SPECTRUM OF POTENTIAL THREATS OR HAZARDS THAT YOU MAY FACE? THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS MAY BE HELPFUL TO ASK WHEN SETTING UP A CHURCH SECURITY TEAM:

- 1. What are the basic requirements to become a member of your church security team?
- 2. Did each team member successfully pass a criminal background check?
- 3. What is the job description of this volunteer position? Expectations/limitations?
- 4. What insurance coverage does your church need for armed and unarmed team members?
- 5. Do you need to install/use video cameras? If so, where should they be placed? Who will monitor this video feed? Will the cameras be monitored in real time?
- 6. Who is responsible for responding to perceived threats and inappropriate behaviors?
- 7. What are some preventative security measures you need to consider as a church?
- 8. Who will be responsible for implementing and enforcing these procedures (locking doors; engaging the intoxicated persons and suspicious persons; parking lot patrols, etc.)?
- 9. How will you budget and plan for ongoing training?
- 10. Is there a budget to purchase and maintain equipment?
- 11. Equipment may include the following: radios, video equipment, or the use of off-duty police officers or security personnel.
- 12. What consistent method will your church use for documenting and reporting security incidents?
- 13. Will the team be responsible for responding to health emergencies?
- 14. If so, will there be first-aid and AED training provided by the church?
- 15. Will the team be responsible for receiving reports of abuse allegations and responding appropriately?
- 16. Are there local law enforcement resources who can be contacted for facility assessments and security training?
- 17. What are local law enforcement expectations for the church security team?
- 18. What are the first steps law enforcement will take when arriving at your church?
- 19. Will there be a contact person from the church for local law enforcement?
