

Hello Dear Friends,

You are all in our prayers often as you serve so faithfully. Thank you for the support, encouragement, friendship, and training you offer the churches you serve.

It is a joy for Baptists on Mission to serve you. While the Baptist Building has been closed since mid-March, the staff of Baptists on Mission has been able to continue to work a good bit from our offices. For March and April we rotated our staff so that about half of us were in Cary each day and the others worked from home.

Farmers to Families Food Boxes

On May 1 we applied for the USDA Farmers to Families Food Program. This program is designed to help farmers affected by the COVID-19 pandemic move their products to those in need rather than have it wasted because of a lack of delivery options. You saw many reports in March and April of produce, milk, and animals being destroyed. We were notified on May 8 that we had been awarded the grant and began delivery of food boxes on May 15. Since then, it has been all-hands-on-deck and nearly all Baptists on Mission staff have worked from the office as we coordinated the delivery of 13,000 food boxes per week (8000 produce boxes, 2000 meat boxes, 2000 gallons of milk, and 1000 boxes of cheese. Many of you have covered "the last mile" in getting these boxes into the hands of families with nutrition needs. Last week we heard that we had the grant renewed for July - August, so we will deliver 12,000 boxes per week from July 6 - August 29.

Rebuild Sites

Our rebuild sites in Rose Hill, Lumberton, New Bern, Pender County, Wilmington, and Kelly are all still assisting families whose homes were damaged by Hurricane Florence.
