### FIELD TRIP—ST. OLAF COLLEGE

On Monday we will visit St. Olaf College in Northfield, the site of ALCM's constituting convention in 1986. During this visit Chad Fothergill and Daniel Schwandt will begin discussion of the cantor in the 21st century, and we will join in opening worship. ALCM member Jamie Bobb will be our principal musician, introducing us to a new liturgical setting he has written.

### NATIONAL LUTHERAN CHOIR

Under the direction of nationally known conductor, composer, and organist Dr. David Cherwien, the 64-member National Lutheran Choir's artistry is rooted in its mission to strengthen, renew and preserve the heritage of sacred choral music. And it does so through the highest standards of performance and literature. Dr. Cherwien and the choir will lead a hymn festival on Tuesday evening at St. Olaf Catholic Church.



### FIELD TRIP—ST. JOHN'S ABBEY

In 2017 many Lutherans and Roman Catholics will jointly commemorate the 500th anniversary of the Reformation. Wednesday's field trip will be to St. John's Abbey in Collegeville, a well-known locus for liturgical renewal and ecumenism in this country. Our visit will include three short plenaries, dinner, and a service of evening prayer with the monastic community.
