Description

Recent events have focused the attention of our country on the need for equity and steps to eliminate racism and other biases in our society. Adult education addresses equity in some ways by its very existence, but there is more work to do. In this training, you will learn about the cultural competence framework and the role of unconscious bias. You will share a definition of equity and explore program and classroom practices that support equity for all students, and then consider ways of using program data to identify equity issues. The goal is to be able to create an open and welcoming environment where students of all cultures and ethnicities get the support they need to work toward their educational goals.
