Dr. Mike Lebrias is a conductor, music educator, & content creator residing in Austin, Texas. He currently serves as an Assistant Director of Bands and Director of Creative Media for the University of Texas Bands department, where he co-teaches the Longhorn Band & Longhorn Pep Band, conducts the Austin Youth Wind Ensemble, and oversees content creation efforts for the department of bands. Dr. Lebrias also maintains his own social media channels – he enjoys making content geared towards providing educational music and conducting content to his viewers, and aims to help bring the Wind Band art form, its composers, and its music into the mainstream.

Dr. Lebrias has been fortunate enough to conduct ensembles at all levels of performance – from middle school honor bands to professional wind bands; he keeps an active schedule as a clinician, music arranger, and a content creator for wind music – creating content for composers & professional wind bands across the country. He has made conducting appearances with all-district & region bands, professional bands, the United States Air Force Band, and British-style brass bands alike. Dr. Lebrias is also active in the transcription and arrangement realm, where he has transcribed multiple works for winds, including Leonard Bernstein's *Symphony No. 1, "Jeremiah"* for Wind Ensemble and John Psathas' *Orbital* for Percussion Quartet & Wind Ensemble – in addition to a large body of arrangement work for collegiate and high school marching bands. As a content creator, Dr. Lebrias has helped create content for the University of Texas Longhorn Band (@longhornband) & The University of Texas Bands (@utexasbands), and the Dallas Winds (@dallaswinds).
