General Information	
What is <i>SmartPrep</i> ?	<i>SmartPrep</i> is a series of high-quality, affordable workshops designed to help students prepare for the ACT college entrance exam.
Instructor:	Mrs. Gina Smearsoll - Mrs. Smearsoll is currently a Senior High Science Teacher and a test prep instructor. She has been teaching ACT and SAT Test Preparation courses for 19 years.

Which test does this prepare students to take?

The focus of the Fall 2018 workshops and practice sessions will be on the **ACT only**. All workshops and practice sessions will be completed before the national ACT test administration date on **October 27, 2018**.

Who should register?

These workshops and practice sessions are designed for **high school juniors or seniors.** Sophomores are permitted in the sessions but may not yet have covered the math material included on the ACT in their school courses.

How do I get started?

All students should start by taking a **full-length practice ACT test.** Students that have already taken an official ACT test can submit those scores instead of taking the full-length introductory test. If students have not yet taken the ACT, they will be given a practice test to take home and complete **before** starting any workshops or practice sessions. After completing the test, students should turn the test in to Mrs. Smearsoll. She will grade the test within one day and have the score back to the student. This gives the student a baseline from which to work.

Why workshops AND practice sessions?

There are two important steps necessary in preparing for college entrance exams. **First, students must learn the format and specific strategies to score well on each section of the exam**. This is the focus of the individual workshops. **Second, students must use those strategies and practice on real questions in the time allotted for each exam section.** This is the focus of the practice sessions. Often, students may learn the format and strategies for each section BUT they fail to use those strategies to practice for the exam. By scheduling intentional practice sessions, students have the opportunity to come and practice before taking the actual test. Practice sessions will benefit the student most after attending the workshop for that section to learn the format and strategies. **For that reason, students may only attend practice sessions after attending the corresponding workshop**.

Why is there a book fee? All students will be provided with the same practice book for use in all sessions.

Workshops

ACT English Workshop

Workshop Description: This workshop focuses specifically on the English section of the ACT. Students will learn what kinds of topics are and are NOT asked on this portion of the test. Students will then be exposed to usage and mechanics questions that focus on punctuation, grammar, usage, and sentence structure and rhetorical skills questions that focus on strategy, organization, and style.

ACT Math Basics Workshop

Workshop Description: This workshop will focus specifically on the Math section of the ACT. Students will learn the format for the math section and how to best answer multiple-choice and grid-in questions. Students will be guided through some of the most frequently asked math question types. *Students need to bring a calculator.

ACT Reading Comprehension Workshop

Workshop Description: This workshop will focus on the Reading section of the ACT. Students will learn the question types for the test, strategies for short and long reading comprehension passages, and basic principles for understanding what is read.

ACT Science Reasoning Workshop

Workshop Description: This workshop will focus specifically on the Science Reasoning section of the ACT. Students will be guided through the skills necessary to score well on this portion of the test. These skills include interpretation, analysis, evaluation, reasoning, and problem solving.
