
Our reunion took place on September 16, 2017 at Borgia High School.

What songs are on your 90's playlist?




My life now, is surrounded by flowers and cattle. But I have left my heart in the hands of the 300 children I look after in India.

Very different. Now I have the Holy Spirit. Back then I was selfish and living for myself.








Different from high school...well, I have more wrinkles, more laugh lines, more empathy, less tolerance for mean people, more confidence in who I am, less worries

What are you currently obsessed with? Other than my family, my current obsessions learning to ski and fly fish (not at the same time), building a camper van (seriously), and anything on two wheels.



People you actually see/keep up with from high school, Facebook doesn't count. Does Instagram count? From



Do you live outside the St. Louis area, and if so, what is your favorite local food to eat when you are back in the area?


Yes. In Tampa, Cuban food is a must. Cuban sandwiches and black beans and rice.

I live in town and still pissed that Patke's closed :(





Those were my jams.



What are you currently obsessed with?






In what ways are you unchanged from high school?

What is the probability of you making it to the reunion?



Remembering Barry



Restoring a 1967 convertible mustang I bought. Just finished assembling the engine, so getting much closer. Also, coaching my childrens sports teams.



Places you have lived/traveled:




Jennifer Juergens Lindemeyer

How are you different than you were in high school? Definitely have a greater appreciation for family and friends, a love of learning and helping those less fortunate.









Todd Steffens
