- **Showmanship** all members are required to show their animal at the Routt County Fair. All members are required to show in showmanship, and can show in breeding, dairy, and market classes depending on their project and the goals they have set.
- **Record Books** must be completed with your projects. These books will be turned in to the Routt County Extension Office in September.

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
