On behalf of the entire SBT GRVL team, we hope that this email finds you well and that you are enjoying your Summer. We wanted to take this opportunity to relay some key information about our upcoming event in August.

We know that you are busy preparing for the Routt County Fair and can confirm that our future SBT GRVL events will not coincide with the historic event. In the interim, please see below for key information that will be useful as you plan logistics.

Starting August 14th until August 19th, we will have a Community Command Center phone line available. The number is (720) 805-9751. This phone line is intended for our community members to be able to reach an official SBT GRVL team member to communicate safety, medical, or stewardship concerns with a confirmed SBT GRVL rider.

Below is the SBT GRVL schedule of events.

Friday, August 16 Activities (Expo Day):

- 9am: Group rides
 - Ride leaving from Little Toots Park on the Core Trail and back on River Road
 - Ride starting and finishing in Hayden
- 9:00am: Vendors and Expo setup begins, Yampa Street closed from 9th St. to 12th St.
- 12:00pm - 5:00pm: Expo on Yampa Street between 9th and 12th Street, Public welcome
- 5:30pm: Hill Climb Challenge (Howelsen Hill)
- 6:00pm: [FLM FST](#) (Bud Werner Memorial Library) - free, Public welcome

Saturday, August 17 Activities (Expo Day):

- 6:00am: Vendors and Expo setup begins, Yampa Street closed from 9th St. to 12th St.
- 9:00am - 3:00pm: Expo on Yampa Street between 9th and 12th Street, Public welcome
- 9:30am: Alpine Bank Toddler race for 1-4 year olds at the Expo
- 11:00am: Yoga in Little Toots Park
- 12:30pm - 3:00pm: panels and rider meeting, Yampa and 10th Street, Public welcome
- 3:00pm - Expo closes for the day

Sunday, August 18 Activities (Race Day):

- 6:00am: Riders begin lining up on Yampa between 10th St. and 6th St.
- 6:15am: first race wave will start and last wave start at 8:00am
- 9:45am: expected first race finishers (racers will finish throughout the day)
- 6:00pm: Post Race Party will occur on 10th and Yampa until 8:30pm

There will be amplified sound on Sunday morning starting around 6:00am. There will be a post race party with music and food that will last until 8:30pm.

We will then begin the breakdown and cleanup of Yampa Street until 11:00pm. Once we have completed the cleanup on Sunday night, Yampa Street will reopen around midnight. Final cleanup and dumpster/portalet collection will be completed by mid-day Monday.
