3	(a) In General.—Section 6(a) of the National Voter
4	Registration Act of 1993 (52 U.S.C. 20505(a)) is amend-
5	ed—
6	(1) in paragraph (1), by inserting ", except that
7	a State may, in addition to the criteria stated in sec-
8	tion 9(b), require that an applicant provide proof
9	that the applicant is a citizen of the United States"
10	after "elections for Federal office"; and
11	(2) in paragraph (2), by inserting "and such
12	form may include a requirement that the applicant
13	provide proof that the applicant is a citizen of the
14	United States" after "elections for Federal office".
15	(b) Technical Correction.—Section 6(a)(1) of
16	such Act (52 U.S.C. $20505(a)(1)$ ) is amended by striking
17	"Federal Election Commission" and inserting "Election
18	Assistance Commission".
19	(c) Effective Date.—This section shall take effect
20	on the date of the enactment of this Act.
