Nancy is presently the Coordinator of the Parent/Infant Program, “Sound Beginnings” at Summit Speech School in New Providence, NJ. The “Sound Beginnings” Program serves families of children ages birth to three with hearing loss. The home-based services provided by skilled Teachers of the Deaf, the center-based Toddler Groups and Parent Training Support Groups are supervised by Nancy and create a foundation of therapeutic, educational, social and emotional support for more than 90 New Jersey families annually.
