

BODY ART STUDIO, ESTHETICIAN, HAIR DESIGNER, MASSAGE THERAPY, AND TANNING FACILITY GUIDELINES:

Named industries and individuals working in these industries shall adhere to the guidelines for [Non-critical Infrastructure](#) – in addition to industry-specific additional guidelines below.

Body art studios, estheticians, hair designers, persons licensed to practice massage therapy, and tanning facilities **shall** implement additional measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, as practicable. Such measures **shall** include:

1. Use hand sanitizer upon entering the facility and before any treatment;
2. Posting signs at the entrance and at eye-level at each workstation stating that any patron who has symptoms of COVID-19 must reschedule their appointment;
3. Allowing only one patron per service provider in the business at any one time;
4. Allowing one parent to be within a facility if a minor child is receiving a haircut;
5. Encouraging patrons to wait in car until service provider is ready;
6. Staggering use of every-other workstation or spacing workstations more than ten (10) feet apart, whichever option is practicable given the facility's configuration;
7. Staggering work schedules so that no more than 50% of the normal number of employees providing services will be in the business at a time;
8. Encouraging workers to wear masks or face coverings while providing service to the patron;
9. Sanitizing all equipment, chairs, and tables used by employees and patrons between each client visit;
10. Utilizing disposable materials and supplies as much as practicable according to state rules and regulations; and
11. Training all employees on additional measures.
