If breast cancer is developing, it is important to catch it early.
Mammograms help detect breast cancer early.

Who is eligible for a free mammogram?

Women ages 40-74 who:

- Have not had a screening mammogram in the last 12 months
- Do not have insurance or are underinsured
- Have no symptoms (such as lumps, pain, swelling, or discharge)



Who needs a mammogram?

Women ages 40-74 years old should have a mammogram at least once every other year

What is a mammogram?

A breast cancer screening test that takes x-ray images of your breasts for a doctor to examine

At your appointment you maybe asked to release your screening mammogram results to WellSpace Health, if you do not have a regular health care home, because they will connect you to further testing if it is needed, and/or help you get other health care.
