

## **Kansas City Regional Council Relaunches Public Sector Job Board to Enhance Local Government Employment Opportunities**

**November 12, 2025 Kansas City, Missouri** – The Mid-America Regional Council (MARC), the metropolitan planning organization serving the Kansas City region, has relaunched its public sector job board, KCGovJobs.org, with a refreshed design and enhanced features aimed at connecting talented individuals with careers in local government and public service. Formerly known as MetroKCGovJobs.org, the platform continues to serve as a vital resource for job seekers and employers across Missouri and Kansas counties in the bi-state area.

The relaunch comes at a time when local governments in Missouri's urban and suburban municipalities are actively seeking to fill critical roles amid ongoing workforce challenges. With a focus on counties such as Jackson, Clay, Platte, and Cass in Missouri, the site aggregates job postings from city halls, county offices, state agencies, libraries, fire districts, and utility providers. This initiative supports broader efforts to strengthen public sector employment, ensuring communities have the staff needed to deliver essential services like public safety, infrastructure maintenance, and community development.

### **Streamlined Platform for Job Seekers and Employers**

The updated KCGovJobs.org features a cleaner, more user-friendly interface that makes browsing opportunities easier than ever. Job seekers can search for positions in areas such as administration, public works, emergency services, and planning, tailored to their skills and location preferences. The platform highlights roles that contribute directly to the quality of life in Missouri municipalities, from park rangers in suburban counties to policy analysts in urban centers like Kansas City.

"Our mission remains unchanged: to connect people with rewarding roles in local and regional government, as well as other public-sector agencies," said Ashley Z. Hand, director of local government services at MARC. "This relaunch represents a renewed commitment to building a stronger, more connected public workforce in the region. By simplifying the hiring process, we're helping municipalities attract top talent to serve their residents effectively."

Human resources professionals in public sector organizations are encouraged to utilize the free posting service. MARC member jurisdictions—encompassing numerous Missouri counties—can opt in for automated job postings at no cost, expanding their reach to a diverse pool of candidates. This is particularly beneficial for smaller municipalities and rural counties that may struggle with recruitment due to limited budgets or visibility.

### **Addressing Regional Workforce Needs**

The timing of the relaunch aligns with regional priorities outlined in MARC's 2025 workforce development strategies. Local governments in Missouri have reported difficulties in filling positions for skilled trades, IT support, and administrative roles, exacerbated by retirements and competition from private sector opportunities. KCGovJobs.org addresses these gaps by promoting public service careers and providing resources like resume tips and interview preparation specifically for government jobs.

In Jackson County, home to Kansas City, the platform has already seen increased activity, with postings for roles in county health departments and transportation planning. Neighboring Clay and Platte Counties are also leveraging the site to recruit for water management and emergency response positions. MARC reports that since the soft launch in October 2025, user engagement has risen by 25%, indicating strong demand for centralized access to these opportunities.

### **Broader Impact on Missouri's Local Governments**

This initiative is part of a larger ecosystem supported by the Missouri Association of Counties and state workforce development programs. By facilitating employment in public roles, KCGovJobs.org contributes to the stability and innovation of county and municipal operations. For instance, recent hires through similar platforms have helped municipalities like Independence and Lee's Summit enhance their community outreach and sustainability efforts.
