

## Heaven is Shaking the Bear Part 16 – Dr Hollisa Alewine

So the Persian bear at this point I think we've covered just about everything, we've done everything except a timeline. And that is a tricky proposition because in Scripture sometimes a day is not a 24-hour day. Sometimes it is a thousand years. Sometimes it just means a general time period, like in that day-in that general time period. So we want to be super careful about predicting things or trying to identify where we are in the cycle of prophecy. But what we do know is we *are* in a cycle of prophecy. Whether it is we are reaching a completion point or not, not really sure. But it looks as though the regime of the Persian bear is about to undergo some sort of change.

I would suspect by the time of the fall Feasts, do like you always do, keep an eye on your biblical calendar, especially as it pertains to the four fasts right now, because now that we are out of the Passover season, in the summertime, we'll be running up on the 17<sup>th</sup> of Tammuz and then the 9<sup>th</sup> of Av. And then a profound date as it pertains to the Persian bear, which is the fast of Gedaliah which will be on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of the seventh month. Which Feast of Trumpets Rosh HaShanah, the Day of Blowing, the Day of the Awakening Blast, whichever nickname you know it by that is on the 1<sup>st</sup> of Tishri, that is on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the 7<sup>th</sup> month. And so even though it is suspected that Gedaliah was actually assassinated on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month, on Rosh HaShanah, because the commandment to celebrate the feast overrides the memorial fast of Gedaliah. It is pushed off and it is pushed off, I believe, to the 3<sup>rd</sup> day after Rosh HaShanah.

But truly as you start to see these things align themselves and certain places collapse, perhaps other things rise up, you now have a paradigm for that. You can go back in Scripture, and the Scriptures that we've covered in this series. You can open them up and you can study even more in depth than we did. Because we were just trying to keep up in real time to the events. So we didn't have the luxury of hindsight in being able to go back and figure out what do the Scriptures say versus what happened on this day? We were just running, trying to keep up with the bear.

We've entered a phase because there is a blockade in place, we are not sure whether we are going back to war or not anytime soon. Those are questions, but like I said, definitely keep an eye on your fast days, the four fasts of Zechariah, and of course the fall Feasts. The official fall of the temple was not until the 9<sup>th</sup> of Av. So we've still got some time for a lot of things to happen. A lot of things can happen between now and the 9<sup>th</sup> of Av. A lot of things can happen between now and Rosh HaShanah. A lot of things can happen between Rosh HaShanah and Yom Kippur. So that now that you know the biblical timetable, you know what to look for. And so we are going to review some of those things we can look for between now and then.



Today we are going to discuss the Ban of the Cave Bear. At this point, Iran is under a blockade. They also believe that they have choked off the Strait of Hormuz, but as it turns out, they are choking themselves because there is a naval blockade that is making it very difficult for them to ship their oil out or to get products in. And so they are like a bear in a cave at this point. Their proxies in Lebanon, Hezbollah, they are still fighting, but not with a lot of strength. They've been pushed back. I don't know if they've been pushed past the Litani River at this point, but I know that was the goal, to make it harder for their rockets to find their targets.

Hamas of course is still there. The snake is still slithering around, but much weakened. They no longer have the capacity to launch rockets from the south. Syria is now under a different regime. And so basically the interstate highway they had to ship missiles and supplies to Hezbollah, that has been obstructed in Syria. The bear really has been moved back into a cave. What he can do is limited at this point, especially if we remember that Hamas never has been and never will be self-sustaining. They will always squander any funds that they

have on weapons to try to kill Jews. Hezbollah does not have access to the money and the ammunition that Iran can send them anymore. We just saw how that is been obstructed. And not only that, because we know that they are heavy into the drug trade in Central America. That has become harder and harder because the United States is becoming better at freezing certain accounts. I don't know how much they've affected the bear's cryptocurrency, which would be rather unique, especially after we did the lesson on the crypto bear. But they no longer have piles of cash or crate loads from what I hear, to send out to their proxies, who if they are still fighting on their behalf, they are fighting very weakly at this point. So, the bear is kind of backed into a cave. Our question today is how is this affecting the bear? Has the bear been stripped of power, or should we be concerned that there might be more going on than what we just perceive? And that is the question I wanted to start with.

Is the Bear still playing the “slow, dripping, word” game even though he is pinned in his cave?

The question is, where are his feet? Is the bear really confined to his cave in Iran?

In Revelation, the monster had **bear feet on a leopard body with a lion mouth:** “

And the beast which I saw was like a leopard, and **his feet were like those of a bear**, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. And the dragon gave him his power and his throne and great authority.” (Re 13:2)

The feet are the bear’s pawprints all over the world. He has strongholds of factions and hibernating “sleeper cells” embedded everywhere. Blockade the bear, and he will attack your local synagogue, Jew, or Christian, for they are the ones who hold fast the commandments of the Torah and the testimony of Yeshua.

Is the bear still playing this slow dripping word game even though he is pinned in his cave even though he is confined to the borders of Iran at this point? And I think game might be a good word to describe what's going on right now. Even though it is a sick game, even though it is a deadly game, even though it is a frustrating game, it is a murderous game, there's still some gamesmanship to this. It is a strategic game. So my question, my answer to the question with a question is where are the bear's feet? Is this bear really confined to a cave in Iran? Is he really constrained to his own borders? So, we are going to go back

to Revelation 13:2. And what we'll notice is that the final beast, the monster beast, the composite beast, it had bare feet on a leopard body with a lion mouth.

And it says, *The beast which I saw was like a leopard, leopard body. His feet were like those of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. And the dragon gave him his power and his throne and great authority.* So, anything you already know about the dragon, which is also the serpent, which is also, the sea monster. You'll see it manifested three ways, when we are talking about the dragon or the beast, you will see them as a land creature, as an air creature, and also as a sea creature. The one that comes up out of the water in Revelation, that is going to be a sea creature which goes back to Egypt, which is the origin in terms of the physical things. The things that we see in the natural realm, definitely not the spiritual.

But in Egypt, Pharaoh was the crocodile of the Nile and the passing of authority came from Pharaoh Neco, when it was first passed to the beast kingdom in Babylon. And that is why we went over the basics of that when we started out this series, so you would understand how the dragon passes on authority to the beast. And so the dragon is giving to these beast kingdoms, starting with Babylon, Medo, Persia, Greece, Rome, and now the composite monster that is all over the earth. Where does the authority come from? It comes from the dragon.

A dragon is an air flying creature. There's also the sea creature, the water creature, and then there's the land based creature. So there's an aspect to this. The dragon makes you think of things in the heavenly spiritual places. There's actually a place for him in heaven, and there will come a point where no place will be found for him in heaven. He'll be cast down, then he'll be very angry. There's also the abyss represented by the sea, and the abyss represents we might simplify it as hell, Sheol, it is called The Abyss, Abaddon. Different names for it, but it is a place of confinement for the rebels, the wicked.

And then there's our realm, there's the land. And when you see the beast operating on the land, that is going to be the part of his authority that we are most familiar with because spiritual authority is really hard to picture. It is just it is up there. Principalities and powers, but we don't see them. We can't see what is going on up there until we see it on land. Same thing with The Abyss. With The Abyss, there are things going on that we are neither aware of nor want to be aware of. And so when you see this beast that is like a leopard, like a bear, like a lion, and then it gives you the specific body parts and it reminds you where the beast authority comes from. It comes from the serpent. It comes from the dragon. It comes from the sea monster, the crocodile of the Nile.

Because of the feet of the image, we recognize that the feet are not just the end of the beast empires, but by that point the influence of the beast has spread all

over the world. And so in that sense, we can see that the bear's paw prints are everywhere. Even if we only look at Persia, even if we only look at Iran right now, let's just forget the rest of the beast kingdom that is out there. Let's just look at Iran as an example. The bear has strongholds, he has factions, he has hibernating sleeper cells embedded everywhere. We've blockaded the bear. So, what does the bear do? He can still reach out and touch you because the paw prints are all over the world. There are still strongholds. The bear can attack your local synagogue. He can attack your local church. He can attack your local Jew. He can attack your local Christian. You say, Well, that hasn't happened in my town yet. Wait, it is happening in places I never thought it would happen. Like seriously, Jackson, Mississippi of all places. But why attack these things? Why attack a gettogether for Hanukkah? Why attack a synagogue full of children? Why attack Christians, especially on the African continent right now? Why kidnap women and sell them as slaves? Why attack Jews on the street in England?

See, if you go through the news every day, you realize that all over the world, the beast is attacking Jews, Christians, any entity that might hold fast to the **commandments of God and the testimony of Yeshua**. Now, is every single person in that synagogue or every single person in that church or every single Jew on that street or every single Christian in that village, are they all holding fast? Probably not. We are not perfect human beings. Will there be some who aren't as faithful, not as committed? Sure there will. But where will you find those? Where are you most likely to find those who keep the commandments of God and the testimony of Yeshua?


The Word of God and the Torah are two different ways of saying the same thing. The Word to us encompasses more books, but the Torah is the **seed** of those books. The Torah is the beginning of those books. And Paul in his letter to the Romans was super clear about the advantage of being a Jew, because he says to them were given the oracles of God, the Scriptures. The Scriptures were given into their safekeeping and they have kept them safe for thousands of years. Christians also hold these Scriptures. They place an emphasis on a different part of the book, but they both hold what we would call the Old Testament, the Torah, the prophets, and the Writings. And so, because we know the dragon is enraged with anyone who keeps the commandments of God and the testimony of Yeshua, who holds on to those things, which are actually two parts of the same thing, he is enraged with them. So, who will he attack first? That is where he'll go.



• In the BLB Outline of Biblical Usage, the word “foot” [G4228] in the Revelation 13:2 verse says this: “often in the orient, one put his foot on vanquished.” It also mentions “footstool” (with G5286) in the Biblical usage.

Let's look at the bear foot. I went to Blue Letter Bible because it is just an easy one that anybody can use. And so, if you wanted to replicate this, you could do it yourself, where it describes this composite monster in Revelation as having feet like a bear. Feet like a bear. Now, the mouth was like a lion. A lion does a whole lot of threatening and roaring. The body is like a leopard. We know the leopard because of its spots, it represents the organizations that are used to control people. So there's words like the lion to threaten people, coerce people, intimidate people. They are the organizations that the beast uses to wield power over the things that people need, and therefore, it wields power over them.

But what about the bear feet? It is Greek #4228 in the Strongs and the definition I found was, often in the orient, one puts his foot on the vanquished, and then it also mentions footstool in conjunction with #5286 in the biblical usage. So within the definition of foot, now there's also a good connotation to foot as well. Obviously the bear doesn't have good feet. The bear has a bad foot. And what is associated with the bad foot of the bear? That he likes to put his foot on the vanquished. He likes to submit people. He likes to bring them under his power. And so when we see the bare feet now with the beast all over the world, what is he trying to do? He's got paw prints everywhere. And he's little by little trying to submit those systems to himself.



The Words enrage the Beast, who operates in the authority of the Serpent; he hates those who hold the commandments of Elohim and testimony of Yeshua. These people-sanctuaries for the Torah always stand in opposition to the verses of the Beast's books, whether alternative "holy" books or twistings of the Divinely-inspired Word of Elohim starting with the powerful five books of Torah, the Seed prophecies of the Beast's destruction.

**Words:** Arrogant, threatening roar of the lion

**Slow:** Movement of the patient bear

**Tax:** Control systems of the leopard to submit those who refuse to buy into the Babylonian/Persian/Greco-Roman systems. "Gabriel screamed and screamed..."

And we know the words of Scripture enrage the beast. He's operating in the authority of the serpent, and we know that the serpent was a liar from the beginning. He took a little bit of Scripture, he took a little bit of what Elohim said, he twisted it and created a brand new "truth," which was no truth at all. So when the beast operates in this world, he's operating in the authority of the serpent. He will have the same characteristics of the serpent. He will be a liar. He will twist the truth. He will try to expand his territory. It is what the serpent was trying to do in the Garden. Trying to displace the human beings from their Garden of Eden.

They are maybe conservatorship of the Garden. They have a certain authority they were given to rule when they were put into the Garden. And so what is the serpent doing? He is usurping that authority. He is trying to expand his territory. And because the Word holds the truth, not his twists, he's going to hate anyone who holds to the commandments of Elohim and the testimony of Yeshua because those who do that are little people sanctuaries.

We are little sanctuaries out in the exile. So no matter where the beast might have his paws, the Holy One also has little temples. We are these little people sanctuaries for the Torah, and we stand in opposition because we hold the truth. We hold the truth book. We obey the truth book. If you are not, you might have the truth book, but if you are not obeying the truth book, you are not really a

threat to the dragon or the beast. But if you hold the truth book and you practice the truth book, he is enraged with you.

You have to understand you have an enemy whether you know it is out there or not. Because of who we are and the truth of the Torah that we hold, we have to always stand in opposition to the verses of the beasts' books. And it might be these alternative "holy books." It might be twistings of the Divine Word, divinely inspired Word of Elohim. It might be people who are holding the same Bible we are, but they are twisting it. And the Torah, of course, the first five books, these are the seed prophecies of the beast's destruction. The beast does not want us either reading about his destruction or practicing the things that are part of bringing about his destruction.

Last week we distilled it to three characteristics of the beast, or at least the bear. But remember, it is not a bear in isolation. The beast is a composite of the lion, of the bear, of the leopard. So, the beast will use words. If the smooth words don't work, which kind of falls into the category of the slow movement. But if those slow, enticing, wonderful words don't work, eventually you will hear the roaring of the lion. You will hear the arrogance of his words. It'll shine through eventually. Eventually, the beast will tell you who he is because he is arrogant. It is part of his makeup. He is so used to elevating himself above the throne of Elohim, he cannot help his arrogant words. And to him, he doesn't even think they are arrogant.

If you've ever confronted somebody like this, they don't even know they are being arrogant. So **words** are part of it. **Slow movement** because the bear is patient. And then the third element was a **tax**. And it doesn't always have to be a literal tax on things. It can be control systems that make you pay if you don't conform. And so the tax was between the Medo-Persian Empire and the coming of the Greek Empire, we have this midrash about Dabiel, the prince of Persia, and how he requests from the heavenly court permission to tax the Jews. Then of course we know Christianity is at its beginning an offshoot of the Judaisms of the first century. So they fell subject as well to the dhimmi tax.

So what's going to happen here is these control systems that Greece introduced and the Romans perfected, the tax, whatever it might be, is going to be part of these control systems. It might be literal money you have to pay, it might be manipulating what you can or can't do, it might make it harder for you to access things you really need. Modern example might be health care system. An education system. There's all sorts of systems, but they will incorporate these leopard spots, all these organizations, and be able to use them to impose a tax or an extra economic burden upon those who try to work.


Basically, we are still in Babylon because Babylon was the head. It is still Babylon from the head to the feet, because it is one image. It is also the bear.

It is also the leopard. It is also the composite monster. All these are still part of the image of the beast. And so these things can kind blend together and work together. The tax will use these control systems of the leopard to try to submit those who are refusing to buy into this Babylonian, Persian, Greco-Roman system, network of systems. And in the story of Dabiel, the prince of Persia, Gabriel does not want to see the prince of Greece come. There's been this negotiation, and it said in the Midrash Gabriel screamed and screamed that the prince of Greece would not come. It says but they paid no attention to him. Why would Gabriel scream and scream that the prince of Greece not come?

Because with the prince of Greece come all these control systems of the leopard. And because it is a leopard, it is very fast. You can very quickly bring people into subjection and then control them with multiple systems. Whether it is education, health care, politics, government, sports was a big one, access to certain jobs, which kind of goes back to the education thing. They intertwine. And he, Gabriel, knew that when the leopard came, as bad as the lion and the bear were, it was about to get imminently worse because it would begin to spread very rapidly. And once the control systems and organizations of Greece come, then will come the monster of Rome and expand them even more, into something worldwide.

So these are the things we are looking for. We are part of that world. We are out here in Babylon. We are not of Babylon, but we are in it. And so to be on our guard means to guard against words, recognize that the bear is fine with a slow walk to spread his kingdom. But the leopard, once it arrives, lends speed. And what will it use? It will use the tax systems. And this is part of what Gabriel was screaming about because we could see that tax at the end of Esther, toward the end of the Persian Empire.

And as the Greeks are on the world stage, Alexander's, he's going to be a thing that is ready to rise up. And Gabriel, it says he screamed and screamed that that this change would not take place, but they didn't listen to him. And he knew that yes, the king might have instituted a tax in the time of Mordechai and Esther, but when the Greeks came, it would be imminently worse. When the Romans came, it would be imminently worse. You realize when you are reading the Gospels how hated the tax collectors were? By then that was a thing.



The Beast operates on his *perceived* authority; this is why the islamists and liberal/progressives are enraged when they are not submitted to and catered to even in places where they have no authority to rule. The religion and culture inculcate a doctrine of primacy over all other peoples outside Islam. True, pure religion undefiled was established by Yeshua with a doctrine of service. This was from the beginning, types and shadows, "my servant Moses."

Although the dragon usurped authority from the time of Garden, it is still authority to rule over rebels to Elohim. Islam is one system of the leopard's many methods to consolidate rule. Like Constantine's warped version of Christianity, it uses religion to wage territory-expanding war, govern, suppress dissent through various terrors and rewards, indoctrinate the young to serve the Beast systems, etc. In this way, Rome's iron and Ishmael's clay are bonded, united in Beast methods, yet not mixed.

This beast operates on his perceived authority. And this is why at this point in history, the Islamists and the liberal progressives, they become enraged when others don't submit to them and cater to them. They start out with the sweet talk. Let's give you things. Let's try the carrot. Let's give you things and try to entice you into our systems. And then when you don't fall for it, they will try to coerce you into the systems. In other words, you can't go to work if you don't do this thing. You can't go to this university if you don't believe this thing.

And as they...I like the word progressive because they get progressively worse... because they are arrogant, it is hardwired into them to think that people should submit to them, cater to them, and do what they say. They will do this even in places where they have no authority to rule. If you don't keep up with the news of Europe, try it. See how the Islamists have flipped the script in Europe because their religion and their culture inculcates within them a doctrine of primacy over all other peoples outside Islam.

Now we've got liberal progressives tied into it, celebrating the murder of 40,000 plus people in Iran by the regime. Islam means submission. It is not peaceful. It is anything but peaceful. The absence of an imminent threat, I don't think we could call peace. Because once you fail to knuckle under, once you fail to submit, there will not be peace. You will be forced. There's the expectation that you will knuckle under.

Yeshua on the other hand, He lived a true, pure and undefiled religion. What He established within us was a doctrine of service. And this was built on the types and shadows of the Torah. Because Moses, who symbolizes the Torah, was called "My servant Moses." Moses was there to serve Israel. Israel was there to serve the nations and to be a light to the nations. The beast systems are here to make you subservient. That is the difference.

So even though the dragon usurped authority from the time of the Garden, it is still authority. He is still ruling over the rebels to Elohim. He is their father is what John the Baptist and Yeshua had to say about that. If you are doing what the serpent does, you are his children. And so Islam is one system of the leopard's many methods to consolidate rule. It was used in the time of Constantine. I know we were taught that Constantine was the first Christian emperor. Oh, really? Maybe read the history more carefully, because his version of Christianity was warped, and it was used to subject. He used religion to wage this territory-expanding war, to govern the territory and to suppress dissent. And so Christianity, too, has at times in history been guilty of using the beast systems, and it might be through terror or it might be through a war. First you are enticed, then you are coerced, and then you are killed. So terror is a tool.

The beast systems try to indoctrinate the young to serve those systems, to perpetuate those systems. So in this way you can see how Rome, which is seen as the seed of Christianity as we understand it today...I don't think it has a lot in common with the Christianity of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> centuries...it is a system at this point. Are there great people in that system? I think so. However, as individuals, as a system, I think there's a problem.

In the modern mindset, as history has unfolded through time, Edom, The Red One, didn't just represent the Edom in the Near East. It also represented Rome. Rome was seen as The Red One. And even as far back as the 1<sup>st</sup> century, you see the Edomite, the Idumean kings and governors serving for Rome, ruling on Rome's behalf. So, it is not a great marriage, but there's a marriage, an ancient marriage of Rome and Edom.

So, going back to the mixed iron and clay: iron represents Rome, and certain commentators say the clay represents Ishmael. They are bonded together in the feet. They are united in that they both use the beast methods, but they are not thoroughly mixed.

So, just to review because I gave you those three things to remember as you look at the news or do your research. The bear or *dov* whose regime is being shaken right now, the word itself comes from a word, *davav* that means a soft or gliding motion, to move slowly. If you look at *davav* it means to move slowly or to glide. But it can also mean to speak or to cause to speak. So what are the qualities of the bear? Very slow, very patient, and a speaker. And in this case, we've got bear feet on the monster, but the mouth of a lion. The movement of the beast might be slow and gliding all over the earth, slowly taking over and claiming the territory, but through words and heavy taxation, placing heavy burdens upon people.

So, I just went through the news this week to give you an example of how to look for these three things.

This one I did take off of Fox News and then the other two are a little bit different, but this was from May the 1<sup>st</sup>, and the title of the article is “Rival factions fight for survival as secrecy around Mojtaba Khamenei and stalling tactics expose a system in decay” by Erfan Fard. Look at the slowness of the bear, the patient, slow dripping bear. Here's a little excerpt from the article, and I put in bold the parts that stand out that are part of the characteristic of the bear beast.

Plus, remember the bear has feet all over the world. It has time.

## Is the Bear still saturating communication platforms to issue threats?

“On April 23, 2026, a group called Harakat Ashab al-Yamin al-Islamiyya (HAYI) issued a 72-hour warning for an imminent but unspecified operation, urging civilians to “move now before it’s too late.” The warning was delivered via a graphic, first posted to Telegram by Al-Faqaar, a major outlet within the Shi’ite militant online community with close ties to the Iraq-based Islamic Resistance. The graphic stated:

- 72 Hours
- The Time Limit is Approaching Its End
- No Execution = No Second Chance
- Time is Running Out
- Move Now Before It’s Too Late

Since emerging in March amid the outbreak of the Iran war, the group has claimed responsibility for blasts and arson against Jewish sites and American interests across Western Europe. These attacks have included a bombing outside a synagogue in Liège, arson against a Jewish school in Amsterdam, and multiple attacks on Jewish locations in London, just to name a few. Many of its claims have been corroborated by police and news reports; others appear unfounded, aiming instead to intimidate or instill panic.” “Harakat Ashab al-Yamin al-Islamiyya: The Influence and Origins of a Nascent Transnational Threat” by Rita Katz. What about the words, the dripping words? Is the bear still saturating communication platforms to issue its threats? So this article I took from the SITE Intelligence Group. It is an article by Rita Katz, and I took a little blurb from here too. It says, On April 23<sup>rd</sup> 2026, a group called Harakat Ashab al-Yamin al-Islamiyya issued a 72-hour warning for an imminent but unspecified operation urging civilians to move now before it is too late. The warning was delivered via a graphic first posted to Telegram by Alfakar, a major outlet within the Shiite militant online community with close ties to the Iraq based Islamic resistance. So you see the bear might be in the cave in Iran, but this arm in Iraq steps in. The graphic stated 72 hours. The time limit is approaching its end. No execution, no second chance. Time is running out. Move now before it is too late. Since emerging in March, amid the outbreak of the Iran War, the group has claimed responsibility for blasts and arson against Jewish sites and American interests across Western Europe. These attacks have included a bombing outside a synagogue in Liege, arson against a Jewish school in Amsterdam, multiple attacks on Jewish locations in London, just to name a few. Many of its claims have been corroborated by police and news reports. Others appear unfounded, aiming instead to intimidate or instill panic.

So, the bear is using words. It is using digital, social media. It is out there. It is threatening. It has the mouth of a lion. But the bear prince, that slow approach

is little by little taking its territory. It believes it is entitled to it. And according to this report, yes many of the things it says are going to happen, the attacks it makes on Jews, the attacks that it does make upon various institutions, do they happen? Many of them do, but they'll also throw some in there that are not going to happen. But what they are trying to do is to instill panic, entice, coerce, kill. That is how the beast works. So yes, it is still using words, it is still using communication, it is still delaying for time.

Review: the iron and clay feet of the beast image represent the kingdom of Ishmael/Edom(Esau):



- Esau said to his father, “Do you have only one blessing, my father? Bless me, even me also, O my father.” So Esau lifted his voice and wept. (Ge 27:38)
- See to it that no one comes short of the grace of God; that **no root of bitterness springing up causes trouble**, and by it many be defiled; that there be no immoral or godless person like Esau, who sold his own birthright for a single meal. **For you know that even afterwards, when he desired to inherit the blessing, he was rejected**, for he found no place for repentance, though he sought for it with tears. (He 12:15-17)

Next week I want to go over why is the beast like this? Why is Edom like this? I want to go back and look at the spiritual biblical roots of what's going on with Edom, and even Ishmael. And I think there's an explanation, and while the explanation may not change conditions on the ground, so to speak, sometimes if we understand why something is, we can deal with it a little bit better. After all, Yeshua called us to be servants, to be the light to the world. And we are going to suffer for being that light to the world. But if we know there's a reason for it, we'll endure anything.

Jacob had some insights to his brother Esau. He had Edom figured out. And you can see how he approached him as Esau is on his way with his armed men presumably to kill Jacob, like he said he was going to. And you saw how Jacob handled him. Maybe we can learn some things from that. Maybe not. But I believe the biblical pattern will have something we can hold on to there.

But in the end, guys, this is pretty heavy stuff. I mean, it is not for the faint of heart. But how many years did we read in Revelation that says that the dragon is enraged with the children of the woman who keep the testimony of Yeshua and the commandments of God? We've read that, and somehow thought we

were exempt, like somehow it would skip a generation. It hasn't. The dragon and the beast hate you. If you are a believer, if you are doing the best you can to walk in the divinely inspired Scriptures of the Holy One of Israel, that is all you have to do to make the beast hate you. That is all you have to do to make these organizations work against you.

Now, does that mean we are helpless? No. What I'm telling you is we are actually the ones who overcome. It is the people who really aren't getting that being saved is not a get out of jail free card. They've met Messiah Yeshua, but they never developed a relationship with him. I think these are the ones who are going to be caught off guard. And I think these will be the ones that that fall away. They didn't expect to have to stand and fight and to come out from Babylon and not to submit to her systems. But because we did read the beginning and the end of the book, we know what our role is. We continue to be a light in Babylon. We continue to keep the commandments of God. We continue to have the testimony of Yeshua in our mouths and we'll be fine.
